



Firstly, you will need a Go Card...

Buy one from your local Newsagency or a 7-11 store

Pay options—cash, EFTPOS, credit card

Pay \$20.00 plus a \$5.00 deposit on the card.

Show concession ID (a Seniors Card is best). The swipe machine on the ferry or bus will charge you less if it is between 10:00am and 3:00pm as it is an off peak time.

Don't forget to swipe your Go Card at the beginning and at the end of each leg of your trip. If you move from one mode of transport to another, each trip is divided into zones and you will be charged accordingly, but they will be linked.

TO GO BY TRAIN

- ◆ Park your car at the train station and catch a train to Central Station
- ◆ Walk through Anzac Square to Adelaide Street Bus Stop 25
- ◆ Catch either Bus 196 or 197—one comes every 15 minutes
- ◆ The bus stops at Bus Stop 10 outside The Moreton Club opposite Barker Street
- ◆ The bus trip takes less than 20 minutes



TO GO BY CITY CAT

- ◆ Park at either end of the City Cat Route,
- ◆ either Gyatt Park, St Lucia or Hamilton and catch the City Cat to Sydney Street ferry terminal
- ◆ Leave ferry terminal, cross over Oxlade Drive to Bus Stop, Merthyr, for the 196 or 197 bus. One comes every 15 minutes.
- ◆ Get off at Bus Stop 10 outside The Moreton Club. The trip takes less than 5 minutes



TO GO BY BUS

- ◆ Catch the bus to either The Cultural Centre Busway at the corner of Grey and Melbourne Streets, South Bank OR to the City Terminal in Queen Street, Platform 1.
- ◆ Catch 196 or 197 bus to Stop 10, corner Barker St and Moray Street, New Farm.
- ◆ The trip takes about 20 minutes
